The High Plains Regional Rendezvous is a pre-1840 Rendezvous. All camps, accoutrements, clothing and Trade Goods are required to be representative of those prior to the 1840 Fur Trade Era.

Loading and unloading is limited to 2 hours on June 17 and 18, Loading and unloading in Short Term Camp as well as vehicle removal must be done within Short Term gate hours June 19 - 23.

Rendezvous participants must wear primitive clothing to enter, occupy and leave camp from June 17 until after Closing Ceremonies June 24. This includes proper footwear for participants of all ages.

Trade Tokens will be awarded for Rendezvous Events. All 2023 HPRR tokens will need to be redeemed at the 2023 Rendezvous.
